## 4 Questions from the public

It was advised that the hedge at Red House Farm has now been cut. Thanks were given to Graham and Ann Evans for clearing the footpath in Farnham that had become very overgrown. There are two more footpaths that are overgrown, one at the back of Molletts Farm and the other at the rear of the Riverside going towards Benhall Low Street. The clerk has reported both these. Councillor Ayres advised that landowners are only responsible for not causing obstructions bu the county council is responsible for ensuring PRoW are not overgrown. Councillor Pass advised that the owl box will be put up at the end of the nesting season.

After some discussion it was agreed that the clerk's vacancy should be more widely advertised in the Community News, Tide magazine and on the internet. It was also agreed that meetings will take place on alternate months and possibly on a Wednesday instead of a Monday in order to be more flexible for potential applicants.
