3 Planning application DC/20/1969/PN3 | Prior Notification - Change of Use of Agricultural Buildings to Dwellinghouses (Class C3), and for building operations reasonably necessary for the conversion. | Little Stud Farm Great Glemham Road Stratford St Andrew Suffolk IP17 1LW

Councillor Pass was invited to explain the application. The initial application was approved by the parish council but turned down by the district council as they wanted details of the building operation. A structural survey has been submitted which states the building is capable of conversion. Full details have been provided of the building plan and operations. The finished dwelling will look very similar to the existing barn. Plans have been provided to show the existing and new layouts. The documents include an environmental report and photographs.
